- Finalization of Memorandum of Agreement with Don Bosco College-Cankubang



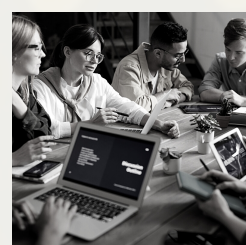
### 2021
